The Government of the Republic of Angola has received a loan in the amount of USD 60 million, from International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) of World Bank Group, for Regional Disease Surveillance Systems Enhancement Project (REDISSE IV) implementation and intends to apply part of the proceeds in the recruitment of an educational institution to implement the national entomological mapping of vector borne diseases in Angola.

The general objective of this consultancy is to contract specialized services that will guarantee successful to establish vector surveillance systems that ensure that there is routine systematic and periodic gathering, analysis, and understanding of entomological data to assess vector borne disease health risk across all provinces of Angola.

The consulting Services are expected to be completed within nine (9) months, after commencement of services, estimated time to finalize the reports for each phase. The detailed Terms of Reference (TOR) can be requested at the e-mail address given below.

The Regional Disease Surveillance Systems Enhancement Project (REDISSE IV), now invites eligible firms/institutions ("Consultants") to manifest their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services submitting their proposal/portfolio and other supporting documents deemed necessary for the application.

The Consultant/Institution must have the following qualifications: a. To be considered, the Institution must demonstrate extensive experience in carrying out field studies in entomology; b. The Institution must provide concrete examples of previous projects successfully carried out in countries or regions with entomological profiles similar to those in Angola; c. The Institution should highlight its ability to form and manage multidisciplinary teams with diverse expertise to effectively tackle the project's varied entomological challenges, as well as the ability of the team's mobilization to work throughout all 18 provinces of Angola.

Consultants will be evaluated as per the "World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" from September 2023 ("Procurement Regulations"). The attention of interest consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest, which can be found at the following website address:
